ADULT BASKETRY WORKSHOP USING RECYCLED MATERIALS WITH BASKET MAKER ANN NAZARETH Saturday 14th March, 11.00 – 5.00pm

In conjunction with the exhibition Basketry Nation at Kingsgate Gallery, Preview 4th March 4- 8pm, exhibition continue till 14th March, Kingsgate Workshops Trust will host a basketry workshop for adults with basket maker Ann Nazareth. The workshop will teach the pinwheel/windmill knot as used in New Zealand to make a basket or bag (kete) traditional made with flax leaves.

Using this technique with recycled plastic packing tape participants will make a small (10cms x 10cms), brightly coloured, bag. The design could then be scaled up at home and, when time allows, used to produce a shopping bag.
